### BEFORE READING...



- ▶ Go to the back cover and read the blurb. This will help you and your child understand what the book will be about.
- ▶ Look for Zibbo the dragon on the front cover and talk about what he is doing.

### WHILE READING...



- ▶ Use your voice to illustrate what is happening in the story. Make your voice go up higher and higher and fade as the dinosaur flies up and away. On the next page roar loudly or ask your child to roar like a dragon.
- ▶ As you read the story act out what you can: "pop" the basketball, laugh, sing & dance, sail and all the other things the boy and his dragon do together.

### AFTER READING...



- ▶ Encourage your child to act out the story as you re-read it. Every picture clearly shows what is happening so this will help them do it.
- ▶ Talk about how no one is good at everything but everyone can still be amazing in their own way.
