## Book Tip Sheet

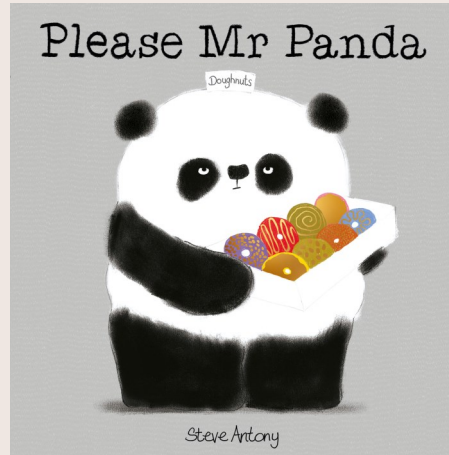
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### *Please, Mr Panda*

Clear pictures and cute creatures make this such a fun book to look at. Mr Panda wants to give away his doughnuts but everyone is forgetting a very important word when they ask for some! Who will remember to say "please"?



### BEFORE READING...

- ▶ Look at all the doughnuts on the cover. Point to each doughnut as you count them all up.
- ▶ Discuss what they look like—can your child help describe their colours or the patterns on them?
- ▶ What ones do you like? Pink? Purple with sprinkles?



### WHILE READING...

- ▶ Mr Panda always has a grumpy look on his face. Try reading the words he says in a grumpy voice.
- ▶ What kind of voice would each animal use when they are asking for a doughnut? How might the meerkat who uses good manners talk differently to the others?



### AFTER READING...

- ▶ Point to the doughnut that each animal says they want. Talk about what happened to all the doughnuts in the end. Where did they all go?
- ▶ Try to notice your child using good manners or sharing and praise them for it.
- ▶ Look for other Mr Panda books at your local library.



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
