



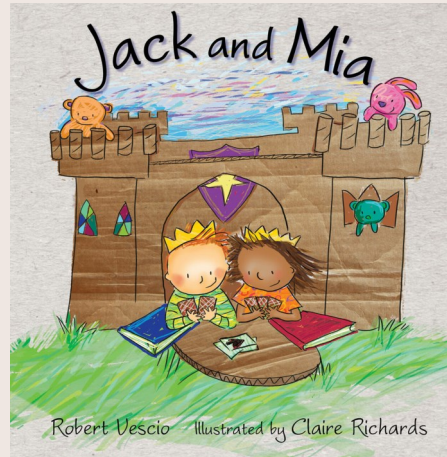
# Dolly Parton's IMAGINATION LIBRARY

## Book Tip Sheet

### *Jack and Mia*

Go on an adventure into the minds of two little people and read about their friendship which travels across oceans. Social relationships are integral to wellbeing and self-confidence. Through social relationships, children learn about themselves and the world around them.



### BEFORE READING...



- ▶ Read the title of the book and point out Jack and Mia, along with the castle behind them.
- ▶ Ask your child what you think might happen in this tale of friendship.
- ▶ Let your child help turn the pages and hold the book where they have a good view of the pictures and words.

### WHILE READING...



- ▶ Notice how the different illustrations that convey simplicity mirror the innocence of Jack and Mia's world.
- ▶ Try to pick up on common themes as you read through this book with your child.
- ▶ Explore the characters' various emotions throughout the book.

### AFTER READING...



- ▶ Let this book prompt discussions about topics like friendship, inclusivity, and careers.
- ▶ Let this book remind you of ways to help get your child's imagination running.
- ▶ Ask your child how he/she can relate to any of Jack or Mia's emotions throughout the book.

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
