
Book Tip Sheet

Through social relationships, children learn about themselves and the world around them.




BEFORE READING...



- ▶ Read the title of the book and point out Jack and Mia, along with the castle behind them.
- Ask your child what you think might happen in this tale of friendship.
- Let your child help turn the pages and hold the book where they have a good view of the pictures and words.

WHILE READING...





- Try to pick up on common themes as you read through this book with your child
- Explore the characters' various emotions throughout the book.

AFTER READING...



- ▶ Let this book prompt discussions about topics like friendship, inclusivity, and careers.
- Let this book remind you of ways to help get your child's imagination running.
- Ask your child how he/she can relate to any of Jack or Mia's emotions throughout the book.
