



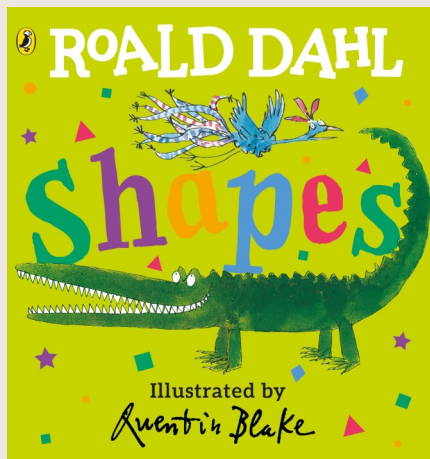

Book Tip Sheet

Roald Dahl: Shapes

Quentin Blake and Roald Dahl

Spot shapes with a difference in this fun book illustrated by Quentin Blake.



BEFORE READING...

- ▶ Help your child to hold the book, or hold it for them making sure they can see and touch it.
- ▶ Point at some of the shapes on the cover and name them.



WHILE READING...

- ▶ On each page point at the shape, say its name, and trace around it with your finger. As they get older your child will be able to do this with help, and then by themselves.
- ▶ As well as looking at the shapes on each page you can talk about the animals and what's happening in the illustrations.



AFTER READING...

- ▶ Look for shapes together out in the world—on toys, signs, and at the playground.
- ▶ Quentin Blake is most famous for illustrating many of Roald Dahl's books (aimed at older children), but he has also illustrated almost 100 picture books! Look out for his books next time you're at the library.
