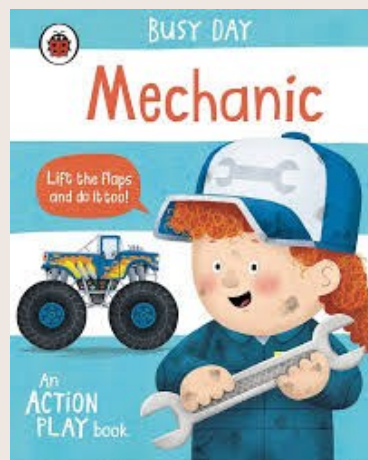
Book Tip Sheet proudly

Let's explore this interactive action play book together and learn about what a mechanic might do each day.



BEFORE READING...

- ▶ Pass the book to your child, let them examine and feel the cover of the book.
- ▶ Read the cover page and ask your child if they know what a mechanic does?



WHILE READING...

- ▶ Read the questions on each page, pause and point to the other words on the page, giving your child the time to consider what they mean as you read them.
- ▶ Slowly slide the tabs and lift the flaps, you may want to do this several times for your child to learn how these work.



AFTER READING...

- ▶ Re-read the story, encouraging your child to move the slide tabs and flaps. Prompt them with questions about each page and what they can do or discover with the movable parts.
- ▶ Encourage your child to turn the pages, pointing at the text from left to right as you review the story together.



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
